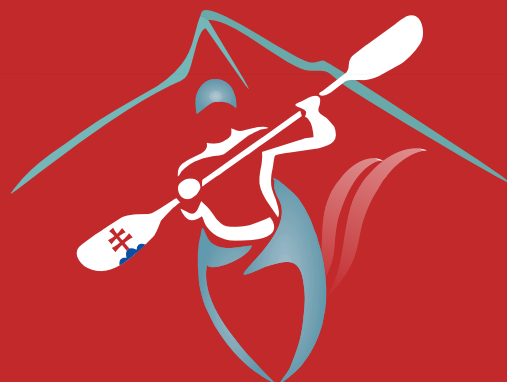

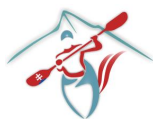
### Offices

## Team Areas

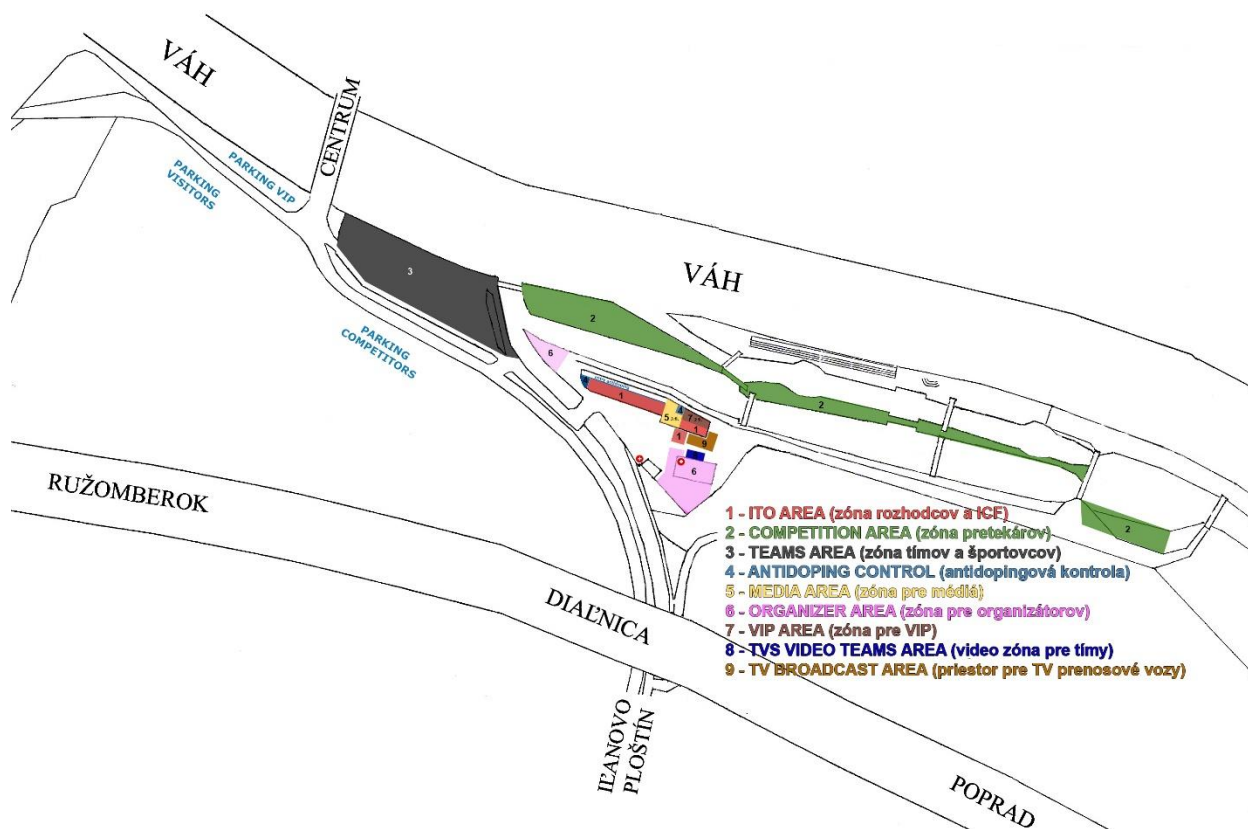




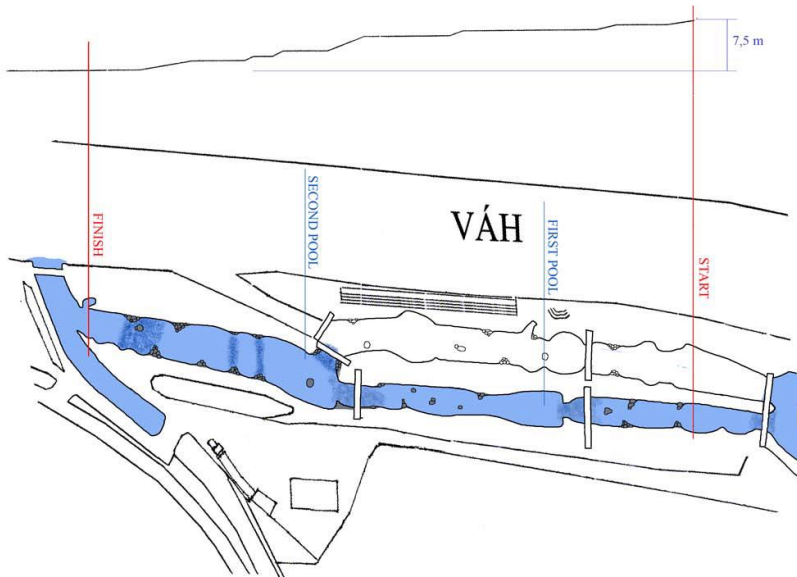


## DETAILED MAP OF THE VENUE AND COMPETITION AREAS

### Numerical Entries

- **Numerical entries close: 21.05.2019**
- You must submit through SDP the number of athletes you will enter into each event.
- Please also give indicative numbers for the overall number of athletes and team personnel who will attend the event with your delegation.

### Nominal Entries

- **Nominal entries close: 20.06.2019**
- Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

The accreditation fee of 120 EUR will be charged per each athlete and team officials for the Access Period, from 30.06. – 07.07.2019

A Participation fee will be charged for athletes and team officials. The fee will include the following services:

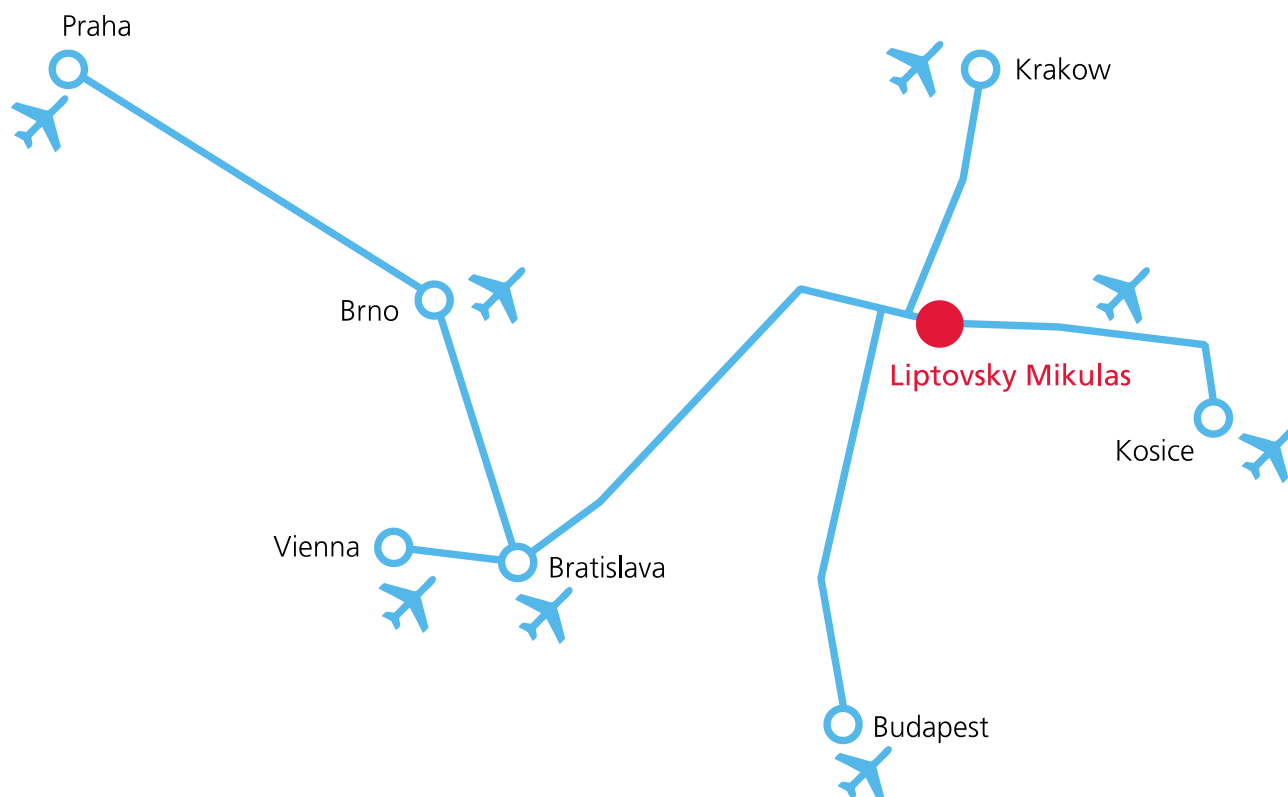

## Arriving by train

Liptovský Mikuláš is situated on main Slovak railway connection between two biggest cities Bratislava and Košice. Fast trains are arriving every two hours.

## Visa Requirements

The HOC will assist in processing Immigration visa applications for all participants of the Championships.

Foreign nationals who are subject to visa requirement and want to enter the Schengen area, with Slovakia being their target destination, must file a visa application with the competent Slovak embassy or consulate general. Foreign nationals legally residing in a third country (i.e. other than the country of their citizenship) may apply for a visa at the embassy/consulate general competent for the country of their current residence.

### **Type C Schengen visa – entry visa**

The visa entitles its holder to enter and stay in the Schengen area for not more than a total of 90 days within a six-month period subsequent to the date of the first entry. This visa may be issued for one or several entries (single entry and multiple entry visa).

The visa application procedure may be lengthy in some cases. Therefore, you should file your application well in advance, but not sooner than three months prior to your planned trip. Under the applicable law, the visa application procedure shall not take longer than 15 days, in exceptional cases the decision may take up to 60 days.

Exemptions apply to the nationals of the third countries which have signed Community-level visa facilitation agreements. Such countries include Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Macedonia, Moldova, the Russian Federation, Serbia, Georgia and Ukraine. With respect to the nationals of the aforementioned countries, the decision must be delivered within 10 calendar days of the delivery of a completed visa application. Nationals of Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia don't need visa, if they are holders of biometric passports.

## Medical Insurance

Organizing Committee kindly asks all participants of the Championships to ensure medical insurance policy in their countries. All costs above the regular first aid, ambulance and physiotherapeutic services are to be covered by this medical insurance policy.

## Doping Control

Doping control will be performed in accordance to the ICF Anti-doping requirements and WADA standards.

## First Aid

Emergency medical services will be located close to main tribune. This medical service will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible to arrange, at their cost, their own medical insurance policy.

## Water Safety

Rescuing in competition area during the competition days will be organized.

## Official Technical Video Service

During the competition days technical video signal will be provided to team's area.



## Weather Information

The month of May / June presents moderate sunny weather with average temperature of 11.9°C

### Temperature

Daytime temperatures will generally reach highs of around 27°C. At night the average minimum temperature drops down to around 18°C.

### Relative Humidity

The average daily relative humidity for July is around 65%.

### Precipitation

The average monthly amount of precipitation is 60 mm.

### Wind

The average daily wind speed in July is 5 km/h.
